



This is detail drawing, illustrating the inside of a large top, as it is finished at the intersection of the different parts which when laced will complete the top A lapel, extending from the section rope to the latchet lines, marked A, measures 5 inches and consisted of a double thickness of goods, attaching with a roped seam to the gored edge of the section. The lining along the opposite side, indicated at B, measures 10 inches in breadth, and the holes at C, by means of which the top laces, are placed 5 inches back from the finished edge. The rope, D, is secured by sticking through both parts of canvas. It is placed in close proximity to the holes and by having a guy at its end serves to relieve strain on the lacing.
