


I hate to use the word 'plan' but the information on any of the Sparks show or any other in that circa is almost impossible. I do have the listing of each wagon giving the length, width and height which was made up for me by Charles Sparks himself. So as far as I am concerned, contrary to any other historian or fan I got it from the horses mouth. The Plan for the Sparks Annex Wagon Number 23 is Plan #0329.

A few comments about the two wagons. It is well to note the wheels on the baggage wagons were massive and had the barrel hubs. Another feature is that the numbers of the wagons were on the front and back. Not on the sides. As the photos show the title of the department was painted on the side. The paint job on these wagons were the traditional white undergear and red body, letters and numbers or title I should say were white with blue striping.


